Technical Tips and Tricks (TTT)

Well summer's coming to an end, it's time to put the convertible away and that requires consideration of how to clean and protect the convertible top so that it will last a long time. An unprotected convertible top will deteriorate quickly. Moisture will soak into the fibers, combine with dirt and generate mold that will ruin the top. It's recommended this cleaning be done every six months, but if the convertible is always garaged, you can prep the top every couple of years.

I'm recommending 2 products: 303 Tonneau & Convertible Top Cleaner and 303 Fabric Guard.

- 1 Apply the cleaner to the fabric top and hose off, then blot dry with a micro-fabric drying towel and allow to finish drying in the sun.
- 2 When dry, spray with the Fabric Guard in a cross direction for an even and full coverage, using a Horse Hair Brush (\$5 at Home Depot) for even distribution and to prevent damage the fibers of the top. (Note: Don't use 3M Scotch Guard as it's not effective for this purpose).
- 3 Let dry for 24 hours.
- 4 When dry, spray the top with a water hose and notice the water running off as if off a well waxed paint finish

In the spring, it will time to bring that fun convertible back out again!
