## Classic Cars

My old Mercedes exited the factory 60 years ago August 19, 1960 and has been registered in Europe, Asia, and North America. We've had it 45 years and with me it's been from the Red Sea in Jordan to the Mississippi River in Arkansas. I'd sure be interested in where the first two Swiss owners went in the car's first 15 years and for the about 60 thousand miles they owned it. It now has about 135K miles and faithfully carried us from Beirut to Rotterdam in 1976 when the civil war in Lebanon drove us out. I used it as my daily driver for about two years after we came to Memphis later that year, and had two bullet creases taken out of it when we had it painted in about 1980.



## Technical Tips and Tricks (TTT)

When's the last time you had your brake fluid flushed? I bet many of you can't answer this question. I'm restoring my newly acquired Mercedes Roadster. Because it sat in storage for many years, one of the first things I did was replace all fluids including brake fluid. In the photos you can see the old brake fluid that was removed as well as the brake reservoir after flushing. Additionally, I replaced the bleed screws that were showing signs of corrosion at the seats.

Brake fluid is hygroscopic and absorbs moisture, turning the fluid black and leading to corrosion of the cylinders, calipers and brake lines. This is more affected by time than mileage. If changed regularly, the components will have a long and trouble-free life, and Mercedes recommends that the brake fluid be changed every 2 -3 years. Take a look at your brake reservoir; if the fluid is dark or black, it's time to change your brake fluid.
